This practice is proud to be associated with the Australian Breast Device Registry.

The Australian Breast Device Registry monitors the safety and quality of procedures involving implantable breast devices performed across Australia. This allows us to ensure that we are providing the highest quality of care to you, our patient.

We will provide information about your surgery to the registry but you may choose to opt-out at any time.

Following surgery, you will receive a letter (Patient Explanatory Statement) explaining what is involved in participating in the registry, how your data will be managed and how it will be used to improve patient safety. This letter will outline what will be asked of you as a participant and clearly explain what you are required to do if you do NOT wish to participate.

Participation is voluntary and there is NO COST to you, the patient. The care provided to you at this practice will not be affected in any way by your decision whether or not you choose to participate in the registry.

The Australian Breast Device Registry conforms to international best practice for clinical quality registries. Your data will be handled in accordance with the Australian Privacy Principles and managed in a secure, encrypted and password protected database.
